#### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the International Enterprise Class Rules.
- 1.2 The Ogston S.C. Open Meeting Instructions will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions.

#### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 All helms must be at least 40 years old at the start of the first race. Competitors must prove current membership of a National Association affiliated to Enterprise International and must wear an approved buoyancy aid at all times whilst afloat.
- 2.2 Entry fees pending

### **3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND RACING FORMAT**

3.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

#### **4 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Registration will be held at the OSC Race Office from 09:00hrs on Saturday 10th June. Competitor's briefing will be at 11.15am on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> June Location to be advised at registration.
- 4.2 7 races are scheduled with the first race warning not before 12.00am on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> June races 1,2,3,4 to be notified at briefing and first race warning will not be before 11.00am Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> June

# **5 SCORING**

- 5.1 The Championship will comprise a minimum of two races and there will be one discard when 4 races have been completed.
- 5.2 The low points system as provided in RRS Appendix A will apply. Ties will be broken in accordance with RRS Appendix A8.

#### **6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

6.1 Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the event.

# **7 INSURANCE**

7.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 for any one accident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat.
