NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the International Enterprise Class Rules.
- 1.2 The Ogston S.C. Open Meeting Instructions will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Competitors must prove current membership of a National Association affiliated to Enterprise International to compete for prizes in this event. All persons must wear personal buoyancy in the form of an approved buoyancy aid at all times whilst afloat.
- 2.2 Entry fee £20 per boat

3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND RACING FORMAT

- 3.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration will be held at the OSC Race Office from 09:00hrs on Saturday 21st April. Competitor's briefing will be at 11.15am on Saturday 21st April. Location to be advised at registration.
- 4.2 6 races are scheduled with the first race warning being not before 12.00pm on Saturday 21st April. The warning for the first race on the Sunday will not be sounded before 10.30am on Sunday 22nd April 2018

5 SCORING

- 5.1 The Championship will comprise a minimum of two races and there will be one discard when 5 races have been completed.
- 5.2 The low points system as provided in RRS Appendix A will apply. Ties will be broken in accordance with RRS Appendix A8.

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 6.1 Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the event.

7 INSURANCE

- 7.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 for any one accident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat.

A. Other Information

- A.1 Campers are permitted on site. There is no charge for camping but please ensure you take all your pegs home with you! If you plan to bring a campervan or caravan please contact Ogston Sailing Club in advance to ensure space can be allocated.
- A.2 Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times whilst on site.
- A.3 The galley will be open for meals and snacks throughout the event with an evening meal planned for Saturday. **Entry Fee includes free coffee and cake at the prizegiving on Sunday**
