Power Boat Courses



We are running the following courses at Ogston, you will need to attend on both dates. Please see the pre-requisites, either course is £65.

Level 2 - 14th & 15th October 2017

Some experience will help but is not necessary. The course is mainly water based.

Course content;

1. Launch and recovery.
2. Pre-launch checks.
3. Low speed manoeuvres (coming alongside a jetty / anchored boat, picking up a mooring, anchoring).
4. High speed boat handling.
5. introduction to navigation.
6. Weather.
7. International Regulations For prevention of Collisions at sea (IRPCS).

Safety Boat - 23rd & 24th September 2017

Level 2 powerboat is required prior to attending this course, you should be happy completing all of the elements of the level 2 course as you will be expected to place the safetyboat with some accuracy. This is a practical course with most of the time spent on the water.

Course content:

1. Principals of providing safety cover from a powerboat.
2. Equipment required.
3. Recovery of dinghies, single and double handed, upright, capsized and turtled.
4. Recovery of canoes.
5. Recovery of Windsurfers.
6. Recovery of Kite surfers,
7. Rescue of people in the water.
8. Towing techniques.
9. Planning effective rescue for events / training.
